

# Stanislaw (Stan) Golec, MD MPH

## **Physician, psychiatric clinician, and behavioral health care leader with experience in:**

**Education:** Dr. Golec received his Medical Doctor degree from Lublin Medical University in Poland. He received postgraduate training at Lafayette Clinic - DMC/WSU Psychiatric Residency training program in Detroit, MI in 1988. While working full time at the trauma level I Detroit Receiving Hospital he completed 3-year Faculty Development Program in Substance Abuse with the Wayne State University Addiction Research Institute (1995-1998) and obtained MPH degree in Health Management and Policy from the University of Michigan School of Public Health in Ann Arbor (1998). Subsequently, he finished post-doctoral training at the Columbia University - New York State Psychiatric Institute (2006-2007).

**Work Experience:** First post-residency job was at the Detroit Receiving Hospital with transition to the Detroit Medical Center and affiliation with Wayne State University School of Medicine. Later he joined University of Michigan Medicine and later worked as Medical Director for healthcare insurance organizations in Michigan, New York, Pennsylvania and Florida. Eventually he returned to clinical care working at Michigan's VA hospitals in Battle Creek, Detroit, and currently he is working at the Ann Arbor VA Medical Center clinic in Canton.

**Military Service:** Dr. Golec commissioned to the US Army Reserve Medical Corps as a Major in 2011. His first assignment was 322nd MC in Southfield. After his AMEDD BOLC training he deployed to Camp Buehring in Kuwait. Later he completed Captains Career Course in 2014 and the General Command and Staff College. Promoted to LTC in 2016 and reassigned to the 246 Combat Support Hospital in Blacklick, OH; he advanced his military educations with COSC and TEM courses. He deployed with the 801-3 UAMTF to New York City with the FEMA-led US Army COVID-19 response on the East Coast (April-June 2020). His initial assignment to the 2500-bed field hospital at the Javits Convention Center was changed to the first line response team at the Bronx Lincoln Hospital and Psychiatric Center. Promoted to Colonel in August 2020, he received CENTCOM deployment orders with the 3rd Medical Command Deployment Support (FWD) and mobilized to Camp Arifjan in Kuwait. In 2021 he deployed again with assignment to the US Regional Medical Center in Landstuhl, Germany.

**OLS Schools:** Dr. Golec has been supporting SSCM Seminarians and the Orchard Lake Schools for more than three decades. His younger son graduated from St Mary's Preparatory School in 2012. In 2018 Dr. Golec became Ambassador of the Orchard Lake Schools.
